About Donna J. Chambers, Pastel Artist



Donna creates with pastels because they present a full spectrum of hues, values of lights and darks, as well as the ability to utilize a variety of textures and strokes with which to create interesting paintings. Donna has used these techniques to create paintings of such diverse subjects as landscapes, animals, birds, and portraits. Her pastels have been in juried shows in Indiana, Michigan, and Texas. She enjoys creating paintings and teaching art because art enriches the lives of artists as it provides an outlet for creativity. Before moving to Dallas, Donna was a psychologist by training and vocation in private practice. She often utilized "art therapy" with patients as a tool to diagnosis and treat symptoms as diverse as PTSD, anxiety, and depression.

Currently, Donna is a member of the **Pastel Society of the Southwest**, the **Visual Arts Guild of Frisco**, and is the 2021-22 Vice President of **Richardson' Civic Art Society**. Donna is actively involved in **ArtReach** as a committee member, and is a member of the **Visual Arts Guild of Frisco**. The newly created, 2020-21 **Texas Bluebonnets Arts and Crafts Group** is a virtual group with varied projects. Donna has been a panel member for "Women in Arts" twice and is involved in "Spotlight" a virtual show showcasing individual artists and their creative art process showing some of their finished works.

Since the spring of 2017, Donna has been the director and gallerist of the **Art Gallery at fILTER(ed)**, a coffee café in McKinney, Texas where she recruits new artists, screen prospective artists' works and does daily maintenance of the gallery logistics and data. Currently AGF, is in collaboration with RCAS and separately, the Texas Bluebonnets in support of showcasing local artists' work.
